September 4, 2025

Well, we definitely had a great day for golf at the Sanctuary and there were some real good scores out there. **Kossman** 76, **Lee** 77, **G. Foster** 78, **P. Schessler** 80, **Furman** 81, myself 81, **Stanford** 83, **Stevie O.** 84, **Suntken** 84. Handicap scores were **R. Miller** 97/63, **J. Jas** 89/66, **Podlasek** 89/68, **Breier** 105/69, **Kleinpaste** 93/69, **Konopacz** 88/70, **R. Samoska** 85/70, **Schaefer** 90/70, **Bonarigo** 90/71, **Bondi** 88/71, **Christopherson** 101/71, and **Flanagan** 98/71.

My ageless wonder club had a few players. **Huddleston** 108/73, **Long** 98/72, **Musser** 93/75, and my man **Gar Ward** 93/73.

There were 7 club championship matches out there. The winners were **Kleinpaste** and **Schaefer**. They have to play more but these 5 winners won their divisions. **Kossman**, **T. Schessler**, **Bazan**, **Kaz**, and **Bondi**. One match found Lee Kaz against my bud Waldo. Lee was tough to beat. He shot 40 on the front but tried to give Waldo a chance on the back nine by shooting a 59, but held on for the victory. Nice consistent shooting Lee.

No other info except Anthony told me he played bad on the last three holes to lose to Tony S., as I did also to shoot 81, instead of in the 70's as I predicted.

Next week, we play Deer Creek, haven't been there in a little while so I have to tell myself how to play:

- Hole 1: Par 4, not that long and its pretty straight, should make a good score
- Hole 2: Par 5, kind of dogleg right, trees on both sides, bunker in front, 6 is ok.
- Hole 3: Par 4, bunker on both sides of fairway and right of green, bogey is ok.
- Hole 4: Par 3, about 150, well bunkered, got hole in one there "once"
- Hole 5: Par 4, slight dogleg right, well bunkered green, bogey is ok
- Hole 6: Par 4, not that long, bunker in front of green, should par
- Hole 7: Par 5, water on left, stay right, have chance to par
- Hole 8: Par 3, about 150 to 160, downhill over water, tough green 4 is ok
- Hole 9: Par 4, pretty straight, has bunkers, still should par

Hole 10: Par 4, bunker on right, well bunkered green, 5 is ok
Hole 11: Par 4, bunker on right and left, well bunkered green, still is parable
Hole 12: Par 5, dogleg left, keep drive right, should par
Hole 13: Par 3 about 140, bunker in front, water on right, should par
Hole 14: Par 4, short, hit drive between bunkers, make par
Hole 15: Par 5, long, bunker in front of green, tough green, bogey ok
Hole 16: Par 4, Long, tough water on right, bunker and trees on left, water can come in play on second shot, bogey is good
Hole 17: Par 3, about 180, over bunker, 4 is ok
Hole 18: Par 4, water on right, bunker and out of bounds on left, bunker in front of large green, bogey not bad

Not as easy as the Sanctuary, but can still shoot in the 70s. Getting closer, going to do it.
