Also, if you were a member of one of the teams that finished in a first-place tie in the scramble earlier this year, you qualified for the World Series.

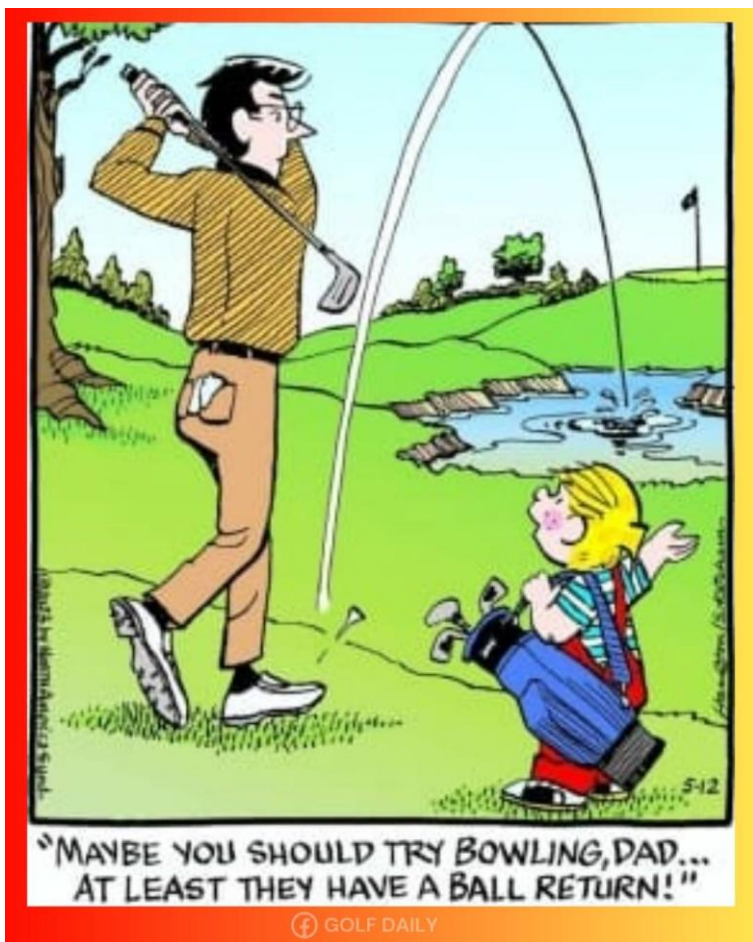
There will be an “A” and “B” division. Prize money will be awarded to the leading net scores in each division for round 1, round 2 and total score.
